



Mo Fontaine: Picture "Cixi" (2022)

This portrait cites Chinese court portraits whose dress code also reflects the splendor of the imperial court. Cixi (Chinese ??) was a concubine of Chinese Emperor Xianfeng and became the most influential figure of the late Qing Dynasty. Cixi's rise to become an influential empress dowager already occupied the imagination of her contemporaries, as she began her palace career as an insignificant concubine in the Chinese emperor's harem. The artist painted the face as a likeness in the classical portrait mode and complemented the design with collaged elements. The relieved picture background was leaf-gilded with impact gold. An object frame for material collages is recommended.
