



Gary Westall: Picture "Rahden castle ruin" (2022)

I often walk around the castle ruins and during one of these walks I was fascinated by the color of the foliage and the play of light and shadow. Originally, the castle formed a considerable complex of buildings surrounded by a mighty moat. The main building was the castle, which still bears the coat of arms of the Bussche family (heavily weathered) on the back. They were the pledge holders of the castle from 1391 to 1395. The ruin therefore has an age of over 600 years.
