



Ute Meyer: Picture "Steep coast I / Baltic Sea / Ærø" (2015)

I painted this picture below the cliffs on a sunny day at the end of April. The green on the slopes of the sand-colored cliffs glows. Between the large gray stones, some of which shimmer reddish and orange, lies a fringe of dark red algae. In the distance on the right edge of the picture, the blue-grey of the Baltic Sea is hinted at. My brushstrokes are expressive and bold in order to emphasize the structures of the vegetation and the cliffs. For me, the picture brings strength and calm into a room. The picture support is a self-covered canvas, primed four times, with a steel cable as a suspension. The edges are painted. The picture can be hung without framing. My signature is on the front.
