



Frederic Paul: Picture "Orange Lotus Mini IV" (2024)

From the Orange Lotus series - The mini works of art that represent the dual concepts of transience and permanence. The orange lotus blossoms rising boldly from the mud and water symbolize the transience of life. They embody beauty and decay. In contrast, the rocks (gray elements) represent constancy and strength. Together, the lotus blossoms and the rocks tell a story of transformation and constancy in the eternal flow of life.

Work of art: 30x30 cm -Work of art with object frame: 52x52 cm -The work can be hung immediately -The artwork is on canvas, framed with passe-partout in a timeless white wooden object frame behind glass -Two layers of transparent UV varnish protect the artwork
